

CHAIRMANS REPORT 11 NOVEMBER

ANGLIAN WATER HAVE NOW REPLACED THE SEWAGE PUMP AT FARM WALK AFTER A RESIDENT CONTACTED ME CONCERNING ISSUES WITH THE SYSTEM.

FOLLOWING THE COUNCIL'S COMMENT IN THE LINK CONCERNING DITCHES AND DRAINAGE, I AM PLEASED TO SAY WE HAVE HAD SOME RESIDENTS CONTACTING US TO REPORT ISSUES. AFTER THIS I CONTACTED THE LAND REGISTRY. THEY ARE SENDING THE COUNCIL A LINK WE CAN USE TO ASCERTAIN WHICH PROPERTY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR EACH DITCH. ONCE WE HAVE THIS INFORMATION COUNCILLOR HAYTON AND MYSELF WILL BE LOOKING AT THIS TO TRY TO SORT OUT DITCH OWNERSHIP IN NECTON.

FLAGSHIP HOUSING HAVE INSPECTED THE DITCH AT CHANTRY COURT AND HAVE INFORMED ME THEY THINK IT NEEDS SHORING UP AND WILL BE IN CONTACT WITH ME AGAIN WHEN THEY HAVE A DATE TO INSPECT AGAIN.

NORFOLK HIGHWAYS HAVE FINALLY RODDED OUT THE PIPE CAUSING FLOODING DOWN RAMMS LANE. MY THANKS TO COUNCILLOR HAYTON FOR UNDERTAKING TO CONTACT THE FARMERS CONCERNING CLEARING THE DITCH.

AS THE VILLAGE HAS GROWN CONSIDERABLY OVER THE PAST FEW YEARS, AND IS CLASSIFIED AS A SERVICE VILLAGE, I HAVE CONTACTED THE ELECTORAL ROLL TO DISCUSS INCREASING THE COUNCILLOR NUMBERS WE ARE ALLOWED (CURRENTLY 9) . THEY ARE SENDING THE FORMS FOR THE CLERK TO REVIEW TO SEE IF WE QUALIFY.

ANGLIAN WATER HAVE BEEN ROUND THE VILLAGE RODDING OUT THE SEWAGE SYSTEM SO HOPEFULLY THIS WILL HELP PREVENT THE PUMPS BREAKING DOWN.
