

Clerk's Report August 2025

The Men's Shed have said they will be making the planters to go underneath the village signs. They should be done in a few weeks, then we can discuss filling them.

I have received the finalised lease between NRCC, NSSC and NPC. The Land Registry paperwork may take a while to be finalised.

I've sent a preliminary request to Highways asking if double yellow lines are possible on School Road. I have yet to receive a response.

Flagship are aware of the situation with the ditches behind Chantry Court being blocked and a flood risk. They will be addressing the situation in due time and agree that it is their responsibility to do so.

I spoke to Highways about the lack of Village Name signs on the newly installed Village Gates. Name signs were not on the original agreed plans, but they will be providing me with quotes on what it would cost to get them installed. If we purchased them privately, it could be around £88 per sign.

I accepted the quote from Redroc to conduct the fire alarm services necessary for the Community Centre building. They have booked us in for August 21st and expect to complete the work in one day.

The caretaker has informed me that inappropriate graffiti has been carved/burned into the bus shelter on the A47 towards Dereham. Unfortunately, it seems as if it cannot be buffed out or removed. Could the Action Plan Working Party put this on their agenda to discuss at their next meeting please.
